Every year, accompanied by ASMS teachers, our students visit our international collaboration schools, and attend the annual International Student Science Fair hosted by a different international school every year, and the Australian Science Fair in Melbourne, Victoria.

- Japan Super Science Fair – Ritsumeikan High School, Japan
- International Student Science Fair – hosted in 2025 by Mahidol Wittayanusorn School, Thailand
- Australian Science Fair – John Monash Science School, Melbourne, Vic

## International Student Science Fair (ISSF) 2026

In 2026, the ASMS has the honour in hosting the International Student Science Fair. Welcoming 35 schools from around the world, Australia and our own South Australian backyard, we are looking forward to sharing our ASMS culture with other schools as students explore the 2026 theme, Experimentation Across Borders.

Different from our usual ISF event, next year the ISSF will be held in Week 8 of Term 4, after our students have finished their studies for the year. We encourage all students from years 10 to 12 to attend as this experience will see them build relationships with students from all around the world, as well as allow them to extend their own thinking, analyse real-world problems in critical and creative ways, and determine actions that make a difference.

The same as ISF, students will participate in Challenge Based Learning activities, CBLs, where they collaborate on a project throughout the week, encompassing the year's theme to then present at the end of week expo.

Students of all year levels will have the opportunity to be an ISSF Ambassador, helping to orchestrate the event and be a buddy, and go-to person, helping to enrich the experience for our visitors.

More information about ISSF will be communicated throughout 2026 as we build closer to this momentous event for our school.
