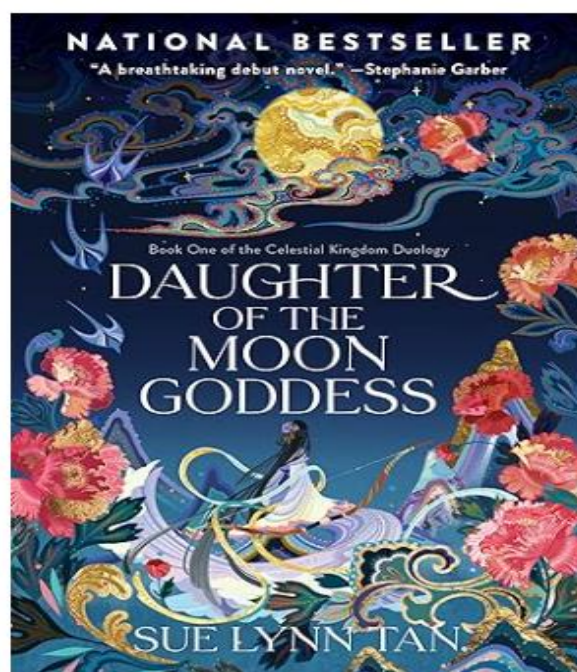
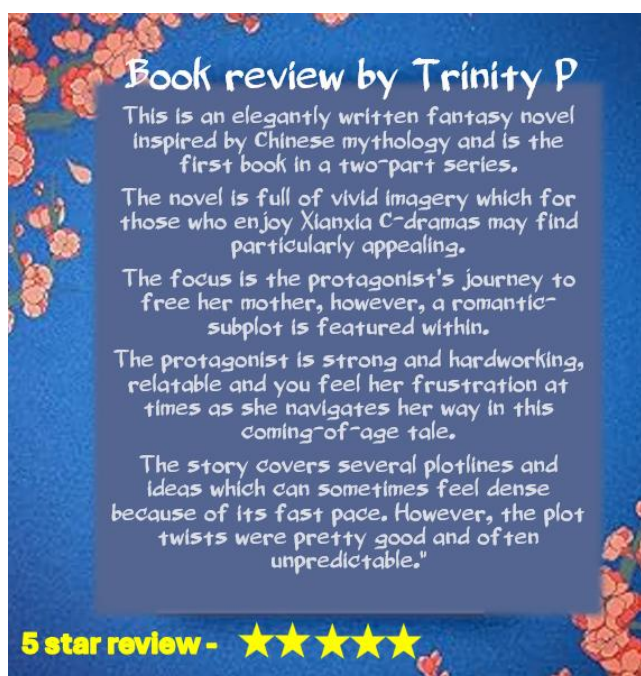
### Share your favourite Reads!
