## Facts About July

**Indigenous Culture & History:** The first week of July hosts **National NAIDOC Week**, a major annual celebration recognizing the rich history, culture, and achievements of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples.

**Giant Cuttlefish Spawning:** July is the prime time to witness tens of thousands of Giant Australian Cuttlefish gather in the Upper Spencer Gulf in South Australia—the only place on Earth where this mass aggregation occurs.

**Whale Migration:** Humpback whales can be observed migrating along the Australian coast, traveling north to warmer tropical waters.

**John McDouall Stuart:** On July 8, 1862, this famed explorer became the first European to successfully cross Australia from south to north, discovering the Katherine River along the way.

**Environment & Wellness:** July is the month of **Plastic Free July**, a global environmental initiative that originated right here in Australia.
