Danielle is an award-winning author of Australian non-fiction books.

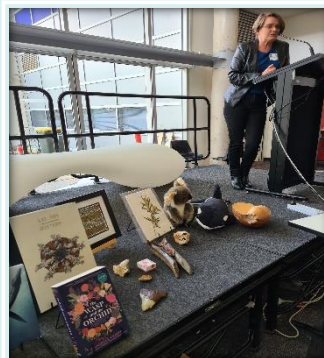
Her writing includes natural history, essays, science-writing, historical fiction and best-selling children's books as well as documentaries.

Danielle worked as a zookeeper before completing her doctorate in zoology at Oxford University.

She has been a freelance writer and researcher ever since and teaches creative and academic writing across Australia. She is an Associate Professor in the College of Humanities, Arts and Social Sciences at Flinders University.
