Consent Form for Incidental Movement within Flinders University Facilities

This consent form details the broad nature of our use of the excellent facilities available to us through our partnership with Flinders University.

Generally, students will be at the ASMS, which includes:

- the building, its immediate surrounds and the pleasant seating areas in the gully at the back of the building
- the Sturt annexe of the main university library the cafeteria also in the adjacent Sturt campus, the Sturt gymnasium (for supervised and organised access only) and the Sturt Oval and the ASMS rooms in the South Wing.
- paths and gardens between the ASMS and the Sturt facilities listed above.

Normal daily use does not include car parks (except when arriving or departing) or other parts of the university. Members of staff are on duty during recess and lunch in the areas listed above if students need support and they also have access to the university security service. There are emergency phones scattered around the campus which connect immediately to the service (8201 2880)

Occasionally we make arrangements for students to use:

- the main sporting fields across University Drive
- other lecture theatres, laboratories, libraries, areas, rooms or museums in the university

Students may be directed to move to and fro by walking in class groups with a teacher, walking in small groups or by themselves or by using the Loop Bus as appropriate and as organised by staff. We will contact you about these occasions if there are matters that require your consideration or consent but generally this is a normal part of our day. We will also supply you with details and consent forms for other excursions and activities in the usual manner.

Students with cars may choose to drive but they must not transport other students unless you and other parents have completed a Motor Vehicle Notification form for this purpose.

Students need to be aware that the university is a large establishment, with significant traffic movement every day, and behave accordingly. This is particularly true when they cross the main University Drive to the sporting fields (not the Sturt Oval which is on our side of the road) or the bus stop. The university has installed a pedestrian crossing and refuge area partly at our request in this area and we expect students to use it.

We expect students to respect these arrangements and to meet their responsibilities in representing the ASMS appropriately in the public context of the university at all times.
